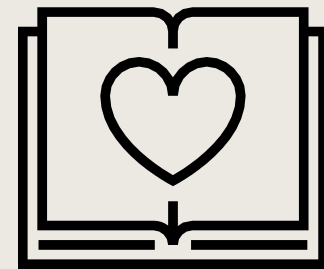

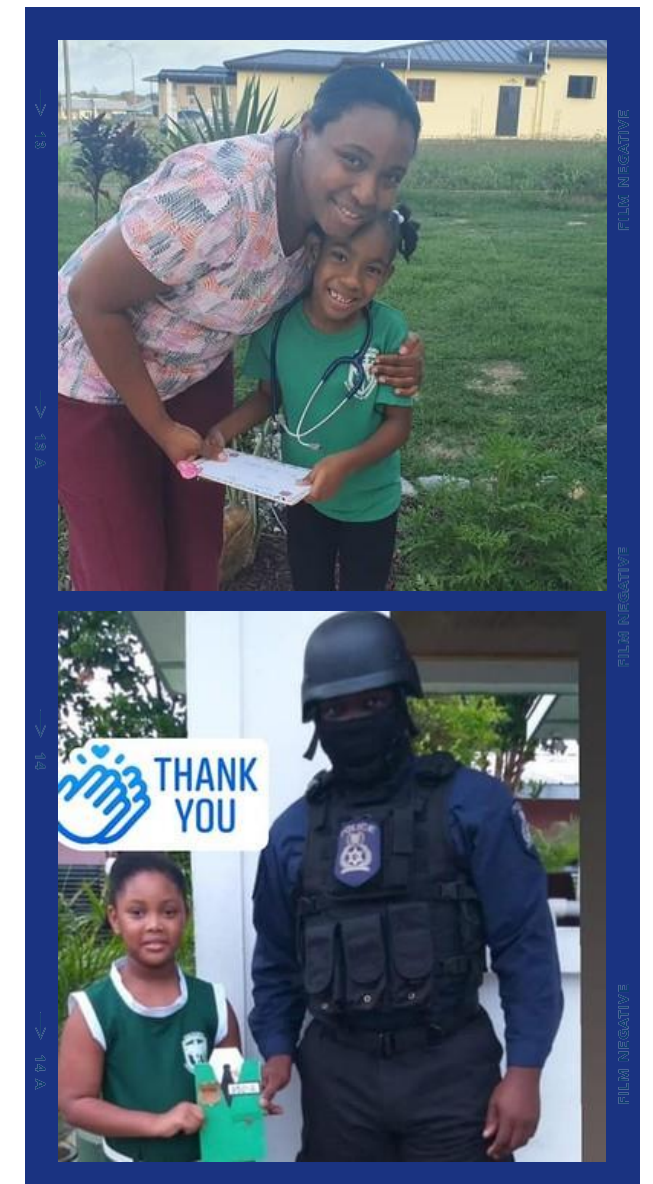


# AUDIENCE OVERVIEW

# S.E.A. RESULTS

In Prep 5, the final year of primary school, all students must sit the Secondary Entrance Assessment (SEA) Examination. This Exam is used to facilitate the placement of students in Secondary Schools throughout Trinidad and Tobago. The SEA is comprised of three papers in the subjects of Creative Writing, Mathematics, and Language Arts, and covers the national curriculum for primary-level education with a focus on Standards Three to Five.

Through dedication and hard work, VAL continues to soar in every subject area. Our results continue to be excellent, securing students in the top 200 almost every year. We have had the honour of having one of our students placed 15th among the thousands of children writing the exam. Consistently, our students are accepted into secondary schools within the top percentile.

Each year, generous supporters around the world invest into the lives of these children by paying tuition fees and also covering school book expenses.

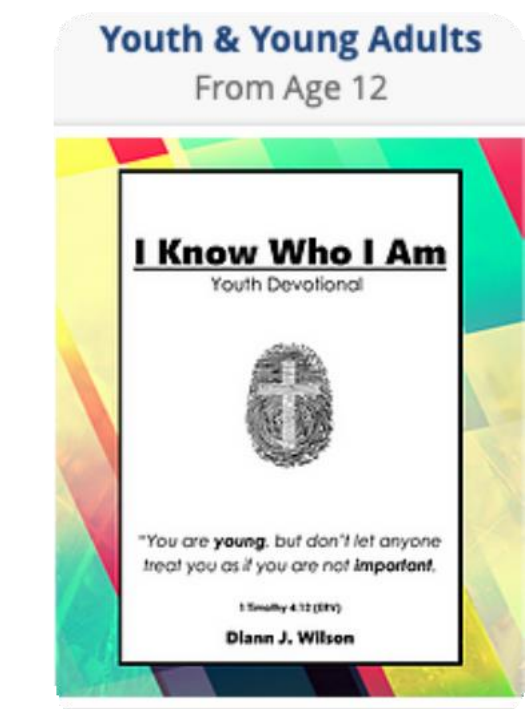
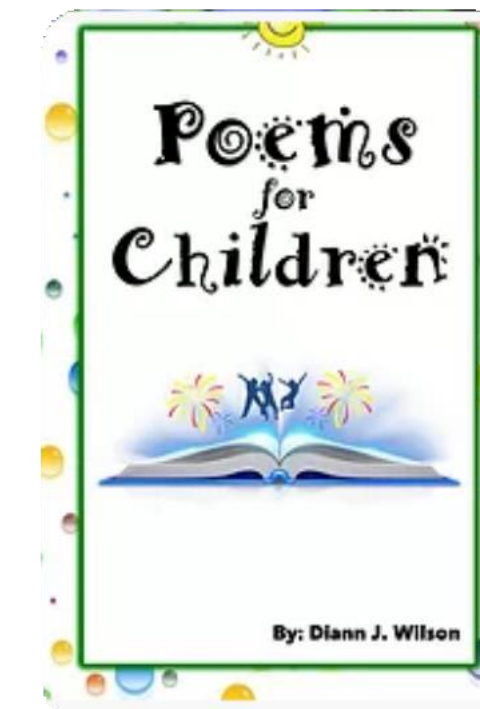
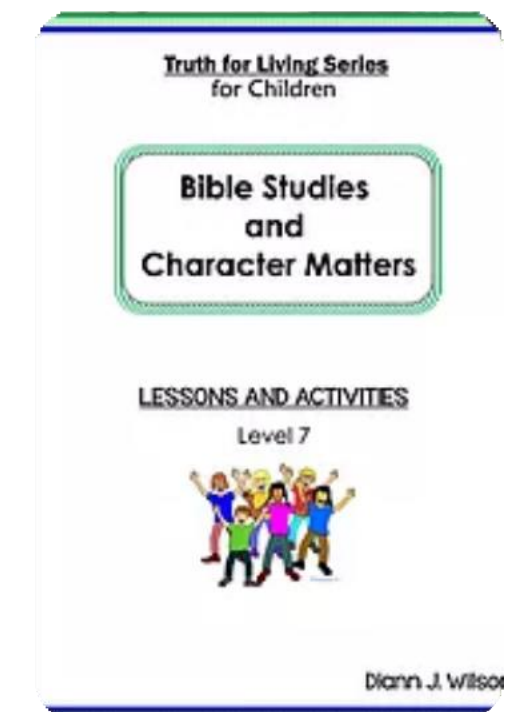
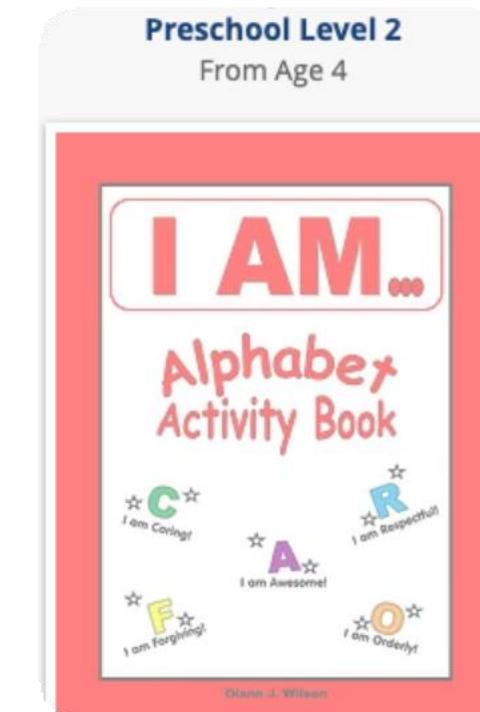
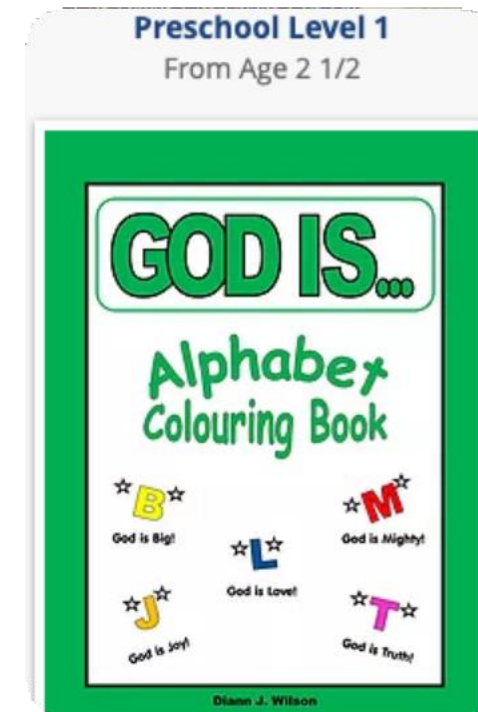
The number of students in this program ranges from ten to twelve each year. We are actively looking for more scholarship investors and are confident that this number will increase in the near future. With God, all things are possible!
